


Sunday Gospel Reflection:

2nd Sunday Lent

1. Sign of the Cross

2. Gospel: Mark 9:2-10 *“This is my Son the Beloved; Listen to Him.”*



The Transfiguration

² Six days later, Jesus took with him Peter and James and John, and led them up a high mountain apart, by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, ³ and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no one on earth could bleach them. ⁴ And there appeared to them Elijah with Moses, who were talking with Jesus. ⁵ Then Peter said to Jesus, “Rabbi, it is good for us to be here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.” ⁶ He did not know what to say, for they were terrified. ⁷ Then a cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud there came a voice, “This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him!” ⁸ Suddenly when they looked around, they saw no one with them any more, but only Jesus.

The Coming of Elijah

⁹ As they were coming down the mountain, he ordered them to tell no one about what they had seen, until after the Son of Man had risen from the dead. ¹⁰ So they kept the matter to themselves, questioning what this rising from the dead could mean.

1. When the voice of God spoke, “This is my Son the beloved, Listen to him.” Who do you think the Father was speaking to?
2. Are you able to hear the voice of Jesus in your day to day life? If so, what does that voice sound like? Do you listen to that voice?

3. The scriptures are where we hear the voice of God spoken. What is your relationship with scripture and how can you build your foundation of scripture more during this time of Lent?

4. Share petitions that you would like to pray for: Finish with the Special Petition.

Special Petition: Let us pray for a greater awareness of the voice of God in our lives during this season of Lent.
